Left Without Being Seen (LWBS) Left Before Visit Complete (LBVC)

How to properly report a patient who meets the definition for LWBS or LBVC

Left without being seen

- Left without being seen
- Before physician encounter

Left before treatment (left before visit completed)

- After physician encounter
- Before completing all treatment, labs, x-rays, medications as ordered
- Before completing discharge process

Take the following steps to enter the information into the event reporting system:

1. Select the Icon for Complications of Procedure/Treatment/Test



2. Select Emergency Department as Specific Event Type

Specific Event Type *

anesthesia event
cardiopulmonary arrest outside of ICU setting
catheter or tube problem
complication following spinal manipulative therapy
complication following surgery or invasive proc
emergency department
extravasation of drug or radiologic contrast
healthcare-associated infection
IV site complication (phlebitis, bruising, etc)
maternal complication
neonatal complication

3. Select Left Without Being Seen or Left Before Visit Completed as Type of Emergency Department Event

Type of Emergency Department Event *

Unplanned return to ED in 48hrs Req Admission
Discrep betw ED interpret Xray/EKG and final read
ED - Patient in 302 process eloped - with injury
